

Training against terrorism Rescue drills by firemen and ambulance crews

In relation to Hokkaido Toyako Summit held in July this year, we did fire drill on April 30th against terrorism at Tokyo Big Sight. From the Tokyo Fire Department and the Fukagawa Fire Station, etc., 12 vehicles assembled, including command squad, pump engines, ambulances, chemical riot squad.

The training was assumed that the nasty smell by terrorism caused at West Exhibition Hall to evacuate visitors from Tokyo Big Sight. About 150 persons participated, including security guards, employees and other related parties of the facilities. Until the firemen arrived, we executed the training to stop damage to the minimum such as emergency call, evacuation guidance, safe guarding and rescue activities. After the firemen arrived at the spot, the ambulance crews rescued the injured and the chemical riot squad performed decontamination work. Thus, a fairly large-scale training was conducted at the Atrium.

Through these drills for taking appropriate responses to any possible emergency, Tokyo Big Sight's staff always make efforts to keep visitors safe and make them visit our facilities at ease.
