# Aerospace Industry Exhibition Tokyo 2009

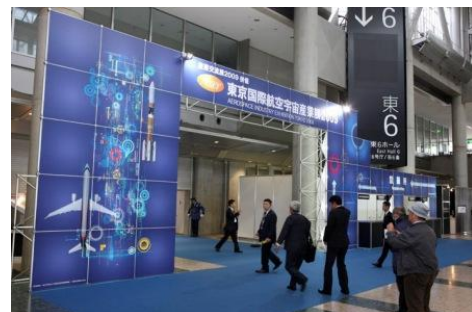

The purpose of the expo is to disseminate advanced technology and forefront information, in order to induce further development and progression of Japanese Aerospace Industry from Tokyo.

The Aerospace Industry sees increased demands in aircrafts and space developments as a fair wind, and the prospects in an expansion of the market for the global Aerospace Industry is promising.
